## Luke 19:1-10

- Leader:** And *Jesus* entered and passed through Jericho.
- People:** And, behold, *there was* a man named Zacchaeus, which was the chief among the publicans, and he was rich.
- Leader:** And he sought to see Jesus who he was; and could not for the press, because he was little of stature.
- People:** And he ran before, and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see him: for he was to pass that *way*.
