# RESPONSIVE READING:

## John 21:15-25

**Leader:** So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, *Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these?* He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, *Feed my lambs.*

**People:** He saith to him again the second time, *Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me?* He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, *Feed my sheep.*

**Leader:** He saith unto him the third time, *Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me?* Peter was grieved because he said unto him the third time, Lovest thou me? And he said unto him, Lord, thou knowest all things; thou knowest that I love thee. Jesus saith unto him, *Feed my sheep.*

**People:** *Verily, verily, I say unto thee, when thou wast young, thou girdedst thyself, and walkedst whither thou wouldst: but when thou shalt be old, thou shalt stretch forth thy hands, and another shall gird thee, and carry thee whither thou wouldst not.*

**Leader:** This spake he, signifying by what death he should glorify God. And when he had spoken this, he saith unto him, *Follow me.*

**People:** Then Peter, turning about, seeth the disciple whom Jesus loved following; which also leaned on his breast at supper, and said, Lord, which is he that betrayeth thee?

**Leader:** Peter seeing him saith to Jesus, Lord, and what *shall* this man *do*?

**People:** Jesus saith unto him, *If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee? follow thou me.*

**Leader:** Then went this saying abroad among the brethren, that that disciple should not die: yet Jesus said not unto him, He shall not die; but, *If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee?*

**...All:** This is the disciple which testifieth of these things, and wrote these things: and we know that his testimony is true.
