**Leader:** And fear came upon every soul: and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles.

**People:** And all that believed were together, and had all things common;

**Leader:** And sold their possessions and goods, and parted them to all *men*, as every man had need.

**People:** And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart,
