RESPONSIVE READING:

God the Omnipotent

Leader: To whom then will ye liken God? or what likeness will ye compare unto him?

Congregation: **Have ye not known? have ye not heard? hath it not been told you from the beginning? have ye not understood from the foundations of the earth?**

Leader: *It is* he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof *are* as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in:

Congregation: **That bringeth the princes to nothing; he maketh the judges of the earth as vanity.**

Leader: Yea, they shall not be planted; yea, they shall not be sown: yea, their stock shall not take root in the earth: and he shall also blow upon them, and they shall wither, and the whirlwind shall take them away as stubble.
