RESPONSIVE READING:

Luke 7:36-45

Leader: And one of the Pharisees desired him that he would eat with him. And he went into the Pharisee's house, and sat down to meat.

People: And, behold, a woman in the city, which was a sinner, when she knew that *Jesus* sat at meat in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster box of ointment,

Leader: And stood at his feet behind *him* weeping, and began to wash his feet with tears, and did wipe *them* with the hairs of her head, and kissed his feet, and anointed *them* with the ointment.

People: Now when the Pharisee which had bidden him saw *it*, he spake within himself, saying, This man, if he were a prophet, would have known who and what manner of woman *this is* that toucheth him: for she is a sinner.

Leader: And Jesus answering said unto him, *Simon, I have somewhat to say unto thee.* And he saith, Master, say on.

People: *There was a certain creditor which had two debtors: the one owed five hundred pence, and the other fifty.*

Leader: *And when they had nothing to pay, he frankly forgave them both. Tell me therefore, which of them will love him most?*

People: Simon answered and said, I suppose that *he*, to whom he forgave most. And he said unto him, *Thou hast rightly judged.*

Leader: And he turned to the woman, and said unto Simon, *Seest thou this woman? I entered into thine house, thou gavest me no water for my feet: but she hath washed my feet with tears, and wiped them with the hairs of her head.*

... All: *Thou gavest me no kiss: but this woman since the time I came in hath not ceased to kiss my feet.*

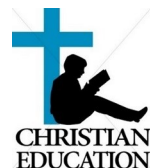
