RESPONSIVE READING:

II Kings 5: 1-5, 9-13

- Leader:** Now Naaman, captain of the host of the king of Syria, was a great man with his master, and honourable, because by him the LORD had given deliverance unto Syria: he was also a mighty man in valour, *but he was* a leper.
- People:** And the Syrians had gone out by companies, and had brought away captive out of the land of Israel a little maid; and she waited on Naaman's wife.
- Leader:** And she said unto her mistress, Would God my lord *were* with the prophet that *is* in Samaria! for he would recover him of his leprosy.
- People:** And *one* went in, and told his lord, saying, Thus and thus said the maid that *is* of the land of Israel.
- Leader:** And the king of Syria said, Go to, go, and I will send a letter unto the king of Israel. And he departed, and took with him ten talents of silver, and six thousand *pieces* of gold, and ten changes of raiment.
- People:** So Naaman came with his horses and with his chariot, and stood at the door of the house of Elisha.
- Leader:** And Elisha sent a messenger unto him, saying, Go and wash in Jordan seven times, and thy flesh shall come again to thee, and thou shalt be clean.
- People:** But Naaman was wroth, and went away, and said, Behold, I thought, He will surely come out to me, and stand, and call on the name of the LORD his God, and strike his hand over the place, and recover the leper.
- Leader:** *Are* not Abana and Pharpar, rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? may I not wash in them, and be clean? So he turned and went away in a rage.
- ...All:** And his servants came near, and spake unto him, and said, My father, *if* the prophet had bid thee *do some* great thing, wouldest thou not have done *it?* how much rather then, when he saith to thee, Wash, and be clean?

APPLICATION FOR SENIOR CITIZEN SOLID WASTE DISCOUNT

New for Tax Year 2024! The application period is July 1 - September 15. The City of Detroit may provide a discount to homeowners who are at least 65 years old and have a Principal Residence Exemption on file. The Solid Waste Fee is \$250.00. Qualifying Seniors will receive a discount of \$125.00. If you continue to own and occupy the home, you will not need to reapply each year.

INSTRUCTIONS:

HOW TO FILE

File this application with the City of Detroit - Office of Treasury. You must file your request for discount by September 15.
