RESPONSIVE READING:

Daniel 10:10-19

Leader: And, behold, an hand touched me, which set me upon my knees and *upon* the palms of my hands.

People: And he said unto me, O Daniel, a man greatly beloved, understand the words that I speak unto thee, and stand upright: for unto thee am I now sent. And when he had spoken this word unto me, I stood trembling.
