# RESPONSIVE READING:

## Jonah 4:1-9

- Leader:** But it displeased Jonah exceedingly, and he was very angry.
- People:** And he prayed unto the LORD, and said, I pray thee, O LORD, *was* not this my saying, when I was yet in my country? Therefore I fled before unto Tarshish: for I knew that thou *art* a gracious God, and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repentest thee of the evil.
- Leader:** Therefore now, O LORD, take, I beseech thee, my life from me; for *it is* better for me to die than to live.
- People:** Then said the LORD, Doest thou well to be angry?
- Leader:** So Jonah went out of the city, and sat on the east side of the city, and there made him a booth, and sat under it in the shadow, till he might see what would become of the city.
- People:** And the LORD God prepared a gourd, and made *it* to come up over Jonah, that it might be a shadow over his head, to deliver him from his grief. So Jonah was exceeding glad of the gourd.
- Leader:** But God prepared a worm when the morning rose the next day, and it smote the gourd that it withered.
- People:** And it came to pass, when the sun did arise, that God prepared a vehement east wind; and the sun beat upon the head of Jonah, that he fainted, and wished in himself to die, and said, *It is* better for me to die than to live.
- .. All:** And God said to Jonah, Doest thou well to be angry for the gourd? And he said, I do well to be angry, *even* unto death.
