



# FEMA COVID-19

## Funeral Assistance

Under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 and the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, FEMA will provide financial assistance for COVID-19-related funeral expenses incurred after January 20, 2020.

FEMA will begin to implement COVID-19 funeral assistance in April. In the meantime, people who have COVID-19 funeral expenses are encouraged to keep and gather documentation.

### Who is Eligible?

To be eligible for funeral assistance, you must meet these conditions:

- The death must have occurred in the United States, including the U.S. territories, and the District of Columbia.
- The death certificate must indicate the death was attributed to COVID-19.
- The applicant must be a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national, or qualified alien who incurred funeral expenses after January 20, 2020.
- There is no requirement for the deceased person to have been a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national, or qualified alien.

### How to Apply

Applications are being accepting applications. If you had COVID-19 funeral expenses, we encourage you to keep and gather documentation. Types of information should include:

- An official death certificate that attributes the death directly or indirectly to COVID-19 and shows that the death occurred in the United States, including the U.S. territories, and the District of Columbia.
- Funeral expenses documents (receipts, funeral home contract, etc.) that includes the applicant's name, the deceased person's name, the amount of funeral expenses, and the dates the funeral expenses happened.
- Proof of funds received from other sources specifically for use toward funeral costs. We are not able to duplicate benefits received from burial or funeral insurance, financial assistance received from voluntary agencies, government agencies, or other sources.

**Mark Dean**  
Computer Engineer  
(March 2, 1957 Age: 64)

Born in Jefferson City, Tennessee he was always interested in technology and building things. He was also exceptionally good in math as a student. Once graduating from high school, he attended the University of Tennessee where he majored in engineering and graduated in the top of his class in 1979.

He would land his first job at IBM where he worked for many years. It was here he helped to create a system that would allow peripheral devices to plug directly into the computer allowing for better and easier communication with one another. While working he returned to school earning both his master's degree in 1982 from Florida Atlantic University and his PhD in 1992 from Stanford University, both in electrical engineering.

During his time at IBM, he would help develop the color monitor for the PC as well make other improvements for the personal computer. Of the nine patents for the technology Dean holds three. He was rewarded the highest honor at IBM when he was made an IBM Fellow, making him the first African American to hold that honor. In 1997 he received two more major recognitions: Black Engineer of the Year President's Award and inducted into the National Inventors Hall of Fame.

In 1999, he along with his talented team would go on to create the first one gigahertz computer chip making it possible for a computer to calculate one billion calculations per second. This would change the computer world forever. He has had more than 20 patents registered for his innovations in computer engineering. The once engineer at IBM has soared to the top of his game at IBM as Vice President overseeing the Almaden Research Center in California and the chief technology officer for the Middle East and Africa.
