

Let's Get Back, Detroit. Let's Get Vaccinated!

Walk-Ins Welcome. Schedule Appointment: Call 313 230-0505 M-F 9AM-6PM

- There is no cost for the vaccine.
- Pfizer vaccines offered for those **12-17 years old**
- **Walk-Ins** welcomed at all City sites.
- Transportation and wheelchair-accessible accommodations are available if needed.
- Anyone needing a ride to get a COVID-19 vaccine shot will be able to get a free trip from the ride-sharing companies Lyft and Uber
- For adults 18+ **Any form of ID** is acceptable. Under 17 years of age will not need proof of identification.
- Parent or guardian must accompany children ages 12-17 to their appointment and must sign a consent form.

- Vaccines offered at pop-up events, pharmacies, and other areas in Detroit.

Other Services Available:

- **At home covid vaccine appointments** call 313 230 0505 to make an appointment
- **Good neighbor program** where you can receive \$50 per person you take to get their vaccine per dose. Call 313 230 0505 you must register as a good neighbor before making the first dose appointment for your friends and neighbors. Everything can be done at the same time on the same call.

FEMA COVID-19

Funeral Assistance

Under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 and the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, FEMA will provide financial assistance for COVID-19-related funeral expenses incurred after January 20, 2020.

FEMA will begin to implement COVID-19 funeral assistance in April. In the meantime, people who have COVID-19 funeral expenses are encouraged to keep and gather documentation.

Who is Eligible?

To be eligible for funeral assistance, you must meet these conditions:

- The death must have occurred in the United States, including the U.S. territories, and the District of Columbia.
- The death certificate must indicate the death was attributed to COVID-19.
- The applicant must be a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national, or qualified alien who incurred funeral expenses after January 20, 2020.
- There is no requirement for the deceased person to have been a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national, or qualified alien.

How to Apply

Applications are being accepting applications. If you had COVID-19 funeral expenses, we encourage you to keep and gather documentation. Types of information should include:

- An official death certificate that attributes the death directly or indirectly to COVID-19 and shows that the death occurred in the United States, including the U.S. territories, and the District of Columbia.
- Funeral expenses documents (receipts, funeral home contract, etc.) that includes the applicant's name, the deceased person's name, the amount of funeral expenses, and the dates the funeral expenses happened.
- Proof of funds received from other sources specifically for use toward funeral costs. We are not able to duplicate benefits received from burial or funeral insurance, financial assistance received from voluntary agencies, government agencies, or other sources.

DO YOU KNOW? BLACK HISTORY FACTS

Hattie McDaniel
Actress / Singer
June 10, 1895 — October 26, 1952 (Age: 57)

- *She was born free in Wichita, Kansas, she is the youngest of 13 children.*
- *Best known for her role as Mammy in 'Gone with the Wind'.*
- *She got her well sought-after role by showing up at the audition dressed in a full authentic maid's uniform.*
- *She was not allowed to attend the premier of Gone with the Wind due to discrimination laws.*
- *She was the first African American to attend the Academy Awards as a guest instead of as a server.*
- *She is the first African American to win an Academy Award. She won for Best Supporting Actress in 'Gone with the Wind'.*
- *She has two stars on the Hollywood Walk of Fame, one for singing and one for acting.*
- *She passed away of breast cancer.*
- *It was her request to be buried in the Hollywood Cemetery but due to it being segregated her remains were not accepted. Later under new ownership the offer was made to her remains relocated, but the family declined not wanting to disturb her grave. Instead, she was given a cenotaph near a small lake in the cemetery that has become a major tourist attraction.*
