# RESPONSIVE READING:

## *Matthew 6:1-8*

**LEADER:** Take heed that ye do not your alms before men, to be seen of them: otherwise ye have no reward of your Father which is in heaven.

**PEOPLE:** Therefore when thou doest *thine* alms, do not sound a trumpet before thee, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may have glory of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.

**LEADER:** But when thou doest alms, let not thy left hand know what thy right hand doeth:

**PEOPLE:** That thine alms may be in secret: and thy Father which seeth in secret himself shall reward thee openly.

**LEADER:** And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites *are*: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.
