RESPONSIVE READING:

Leviticus 19:9-18

Leader: And when ye reap the harvest of your land, thou shalt not wholly reap the corners of thy field, neither shalt thou gather the gleanings of thy harvest.

People: And thou shalt not glean thy vineyard, neither shalt thou gather every grape of thy vineyard; thou shalt leave them for the poor and stranger: I *am* the LORD your God.

Leader: Ye shall not steal, neither deal falsely, neither lie one to another.

People: And ye shall not swear by my name falsely, neither shalt thou profane the name of thy God: I *am* the LORD.

. . .All: Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I *am* the LORD.
